Re: Used Vehicle Pre-export Inspection - Mauritius

The government of Mauritius has appointed the Japan Export Vehicle Inspection Center Co Ltd (JEVIC) for the pre-export inspection of used vehicles exported from Japan for use within Mauritius. Gazetted as per the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2017.

This requires all used motor vehicles, except where imported by an individual importer, to be covered by an inspection certificate.

The pre-export inspection certifies for all used cars, vans, trucks and buses;

The vehicle is inspected not earlier than 2 months prior to shipment.

That the vehicle is not stolen.

The vehicle must be in roadworthy and useable condition.

The auction grade for the vehicle.

Be subject to a vehicle condition report survey.

Not have been subject to flood or water damage.

Age requirements from the date of first registration;

Motor Cars: Between 18 months and 4 years

Dual purpose vehicles: Between 18 months and 3 years

Goods vehicles: Not more than 6 years

Vans: Not more than 4 years

Motor buses: Not more than 3 years

(please refer to and take advice from the relevant Mauritius regulations)

All used vehicles must meet the requirements of this important pre-export inspection to enable certification.

Inspection bookings are requested to be made three(3) days prior to desired inspection date. Inspections can be cancelled without charge up to 15:00hrs on the day before the inspection. Certification will be issued from the second working day following the inspection.

Inspection Fee: ¥9,500 (plus 8% tax)
