ZAMBIA RWI Release Information – USA Inspections

The Zambia Bureau of Standards (ZABS) has appointed the Japan Export Vehicle Inspection Center Co Ltd (JEVIC) for the Pre-Export Roadworthiness Inspection (RWI) of used vehicle from Japan, United Kingdom, Singapore, Dubai, United States of America and South Africa destined for use within the Republic of Zambia.

From the 1st January 2015, all used vehicles exported from above countries will be required to be inspected and certified.

INSPECTION CRITERIA: The inspection is to assess the vehicle for;
a. ZABS Roadworthiness Inspection.
b. The vehicle should be free of CFC (R12) gas.
The vehicle must be presented with an authentic registration / de-registration documentation.

INSPECTION ARRANGEMENT:
All inspections will be undertaken in Jacksonville, Florida. Please contact the booking office for inspection center advice.

FEES: All inspection fees must be remitted into the JEVIC bank account prior to inspection booking, and the corresponding remittance advice submitted at the time of booking. Inspection Fee: US\$140.00.

CERTIFICATE: JEVIC RWI Certificate can be collected from the JEVIC office, or will be dispatched COD, once the vehicle successfully passes the inspection process.
Note: Any vehicle not inspected and arriving in Zambia will incur a fee calculated on 15% CIF and subject to inspection upon arrival by ZABS.
